

2nd Script for Waste-Free Lunch Day

#1: Hey _____! Do you remember what our school is having tomorrow?

#2: Yes. We're having a waste-free lunch day!

#3: Unfortunately, those of you taking hot lunch will not be able to participate.

#1 For those of you taking cold lunch, please make sure to bring your food in reusable containers and a reusable lunch bag, use a cloth napkin, a thermos or water bottle, and reusable utensils! (Hold up examples of each of these for students to see.)

#2 Yes, and in case you bring your beverage in a can, we'll have a special container for recycling cans. We'll also have a special container labeled compost! We want all of you to compost your uneaten food that is from a plant. So, if you bring an apple, you can put the apple core in the bin. Or if you bring carrots and don't finish them, you can put the uneaten carrots in the compost bin. Remember, you should only put the leftovers from PLANTS such as fruits and vegetables in the compost container. Do not compost meat or bread products.

#3 We'll be taking home the compost and letting it sit for a few months. Eventually, compost turns into nutritious soil that people spread in their gardens. We hope those of you bringing a lunch to school will participate.
