- Turn a feeling – love, joy, beauty, anger or fatigue and relate it to one of the three types of slavery.
- If you were to select music for a soundtrack that gives you the picture of slavery, what you it be and why?
- Write down everything that comes into your mind about slavery.
- Pick the first date from slavery and then talk about those times using your imagination.
- Your life is a journey. From where? To where? Write a travel article about this trip.
- Write about an event during enslavement with you as the main character.
- Write an entry telling another person something that you are too afraid or reluctant to tell them.
