

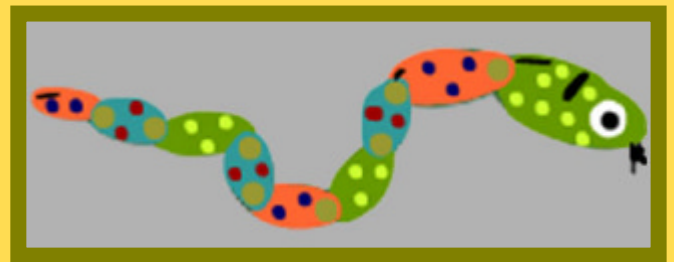


Silly Snake

Would you like to make a snake? Here is a fun and easy way to make one!
(Make sure you get an adult to help you with this activity)

Materials needed:

- Oval wood shapes - one 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ " oval, one 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " oval, six 2" ovals, one 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " oval, one 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ " oval
- Wiggle eyes - 12 mm
- Acrylic paint - several colors
- Paint brushes
- Hand drill
- Paper fasteners
- Black pipe cleaners
- Black permanent marker
- Glue



Procedure:

- With the hand drill, drill a hole in one end of the largest and smallest ovals, and holes on both ends of the medium and large ovals. The hole should be large enough for the paper fasteners to get through.
- Paint one side of each oval. Use colors based on the type of snake you want to make. Let it dry.
- Paint random dots on the ovals. Let it dry.
- With the marker draw the nostril, mouth, and other details.
- Glue the eye to the head.
- Draw the mouth, nostril and other details you would like on the largest oval.
- Using the fasteners attach ovals to one another. Go from the largest to the smallest oval.
- Glue the wiggle eye to the head.

Cut the pipe cleaner into small pieces and attach it near the mouth for fangs.
