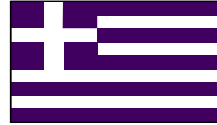
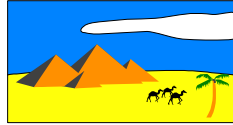


Ancient Civilization Graphic Organizer
